


National Library of Wales Case Study








It is the biggest library in Wales, holding over 6.5 million books and periodicals, and the largest collections of archives, portraits, maps and photographic images in Wales.

Work to resurface the public access around the building using Flexipave began in Spring 2021.



Working closely with the clients objectives, KBI replaced the stone using 230m² of Flexipave in our Elegant Green colour. The recycled rubber used within the material utilised 615 recycled car tyres, making it extremely eco-friendly.

The client was extremely happy with the outcome, particularly as the installation was carried out at short notice just in time for the library to re-open after the winter lockdown.



KBI Flexipave is:

- Highly porous, allowing large volumes of water and air to penetrate the material.
- Able to be installed on to a number of different bases, including standard compacted stone.
- Dynamic, with the ability to gently flex and adjust to minor movement.
- Able to withstand extreme temperatures without cracking.
- Available in a variety of colours.
